Range Medallions

- 1st place in each grade

- Remaining prize money to be determined by the number of entries in each grade

- Target Rifle B – 6
- Target Rifle C – 3
- Target Rifle U/25 – 1 medallion
- F Standard A – 5
- F Standard B – 5
- F Open – 3
- FTR – 3

The MDRA reserves the right to cancel or postpone the meeting, increase or decrease the number of trophies, medallions, and prize monies and adjust the programme as circumstances and weather warrant.

This prize meeting will be conducted under the Queensland Government COVID Stage 3 restrictions. The requirements include:

- Maintain the base density requirement of 4 square metres per person and physical distancing (>1.5 metres)
- Avoid participant interactions including handshakes and high fives
- Limit unnecessary social gatherings (particularly adults)
- Contact tracing information (attendance register) must be kept for all participants, officials, spectators and anyone else who attends facilities and information retained for 56 days.
- Contact information must include attendees name, email address, mobile phone number and date/time period of patronage (time in/time out).

Presentation are to be held in the QRA Café area, approximately 45 minutes after the conclusion of shooting

Safety Precautions

- a. Bolts may only be in rifles on the firing mound or during trigger testing.
- b. Scorers must ensure shooters perform the vigorous cycling test of rifle actions before commencing the first range each day and sign the score card to signify whether the test has been passed or failed. Failed vigorous cycling tests must immediately be brought to the attention of the Range Officer.
- c. Scorers and check scorers must check that rifles are cleared before the shooter leaves the mound.
- d. The onus of safety is on the shooter and the scorers.

Competitors please note: on completion of your shoot, and after stowing your equipment, you must return promptly to the mound to act as check scorer and then scorer, respectively.
