

William James ARCHBOLD



Pre-enlistment:

- William was born on 3rd January 1899 to parents James and Mary ARCHBOLD. They lived at Newbury Junction, Mackay, Qld, where he resided until enlistment
- He was educated at Mackay High School, Queensland
- His occupation was that of a farmer

Military Records

- Service Number 3257
- William enlisted on 21 February 1916, in Rockhampton, as a Private, in 52nd Battalion 8th Reinforcement
- He embarked with his Unit from Sydney, NSW, on board HMAT A64 Demosthenes on 23 December 1916
- Private William James ARCHBOLD died on 26 May 1918 at Villers-Bretonneux, Belgium aged 19 years. That day he was involved with his Unit, the 41st Infantry Battalion, on a "Peaceful Penetration - Low-Cost, High-Gain Tactics on the Western Front"
