

Herbert Gerald HINTON



Pre-enlistment:

- Herbert was born on 23rd February, 1879 in Brisbane.
- He was the son of John and Mary HINTON.
- Schooling was at Boys Central State School, Brisbane.
- His occupation was that of a commercial traveller.
- He was married to Mable Cecilia HINTON.
- He lived in Brisbane prior to enlistment.

Military Records

- Previous to WWI Herbert served with A.M.G. 1st Contingent in South African War. Also as Lieut in Harrens M.I. and S.A.L.H.
- 20 August 1914 Hinton enlistment in AIF as 2nd Lieutenant in 2nd Light Horse Regiment, Brisbane aged 35 years 6 months.
- Service Number: 110, Officer
- On 24 September 1914 he embarked with his Unit on HMAT Star of England, from Brisbane.
- Lieutenant Herbert George HINTON was 'Killed in Action' at Quinn's Post, Gallipoli, on 7 August 1915, aged 36 years.

- Herbert HINTON was a member of the No 2 Battery Queensland Field Artillery Rifle Club in the late 1890s and early 1900s.
- He was a citizen soldier, serving in the ranks with Queensland Volunteer Rifles and Queensland Field Artillery.
- He was a keen and capable shooter and was a member of QVR's second rifle team on 24 August 1896.
