

Lucin D'Estainville GAILLARD



Pre-enlistment:

- Lucin was born in Liverpool, England to parents: Raoul GAILLARD and Laura Jones (formerly GAILLARD), "Glenrise", Carew Road, Eastbourne, England. Native of Liverpool, England
- Place of association was generally Queenstown, Tasmania
- He was educated at St Edwards College, Liverpool
- He came to Australia at 19 years of age
- His occupation at time of enlistment was that of Assistant Surveyor

Previous Military Service:

- 2nd Expeditionary Force - Australian Naval and Military Expeditionary Force, .
 - Embarked at Cairns on 8 August 1914 for Thursday Island (War Station) Garrison Duty
 - Enlisted for duty outside Australia on 14 August 1914
 - Re-embarked at Thursday Island on 16 August 1914 on the troopship the Kanowna for German New Guinea
 - Returned to Townsville on 18 September 1914 on account of the trouble caused by the firemen on the troopship
 - Did not participate in the capture of German New Guinea (Rabaul)
 - Discharged from Australian Naval and Military Expeditionary Force on 18 September 1914.

Military Records

- Service Number: 138
- Lucin GAILLARD enlisted in the Australian Imperial Force on 17 September 1914.
- On 22 December 1915 he embarked with 17th Battalion on HMAT Ceramic from Melbourne
- On 12 April 1915 he proceeded to join the Mediterranean Expeditionary Force - Gallipoli
- Private Lucin GAILLARD was initially reported wounded on 9 May 1915, but on 10th he was reported killed in action at Quinn's Post, Gallipoli
- His war service was in Egypt and Gallipoli
