Stanley Clifford COUSENS

Pre-enlistment:

- Stanley was born in Toowoomba 15 May 1891 to parents Clapham & Ester Ann (Nee Leake) who had emigrated from Yorkshire in 1886
- · Stanley was the first surviving son born in Australia
- · He lived in Milmerran as a farmer
- His brother, 5322 Pte Sydney Leake COUSENS, 26th Bn, was killed in action

Military Record

- · Service Number: 816
- Stanley COUSENS enlisted on 23 September 1914 in Milmerran, as a Private, aged 23 years and began training at Enoggera Army Baracks in Brisbane
- · He was attached to the 15th Australian Infantry Battalion
- On 22 December 1914 he embarked on A40 Ceramic from Melbourne to Egypt arriving early February 1915
- He became part of the 4th Brigade under Col Monash.
- He landed at Gallipoli at 4pm 25 April 1915 with 4th Brigade.
- In August 1915 he was evacuated to England with influenza.
- He was promoted to the rank of Temporary Corporal in February 1916
- On 5 Apr 1916 he was promoted Sergeant, with the 15th Infantry Battalion, in Egypt prior to departure for France.
- On 8 Aug 1916 he was involved in Battle for Pozieres
- Lieutenant Stanley COUSENS was Killed in Action on 9 August 1916 at Pozieres, France aged 25 years.

- Gallantry Commendation: In the operation north west of Pozières from 5th to 9th August he was most conspicious and handled his men with great gallantry and judgement and was a splendid example to them throughout by his coolness and magnificient courage. He made his way through heavy artilliary barrage in quest of necessary information. He was a fine soldier and an irrepariable loss to the Battalion
- · His war service was in Egypt, Gallipoli and on the Western Front.
