Pre-enlistment:

- Percy was born in Toowoomba, Qld
- His father was F.H Davis of Abuklea St, Wilston, Old
- · His schooling was at East State School, Toowoomba, Old
- His home town was Millmerran, Qld
- At the time of enlistment his occupation was that of a farmer

Military Record

- Service Number: 740
- Percy DAVIS enlisted on 3 September 1914 in Toowoomba, aged 21 years
- He was attached to the 15th Infantry Regiment, 4th Australian Machine Gun Battalion, 'E' Company
- On 22 December 1914 he embarked from Australia with his Unit to Egypt
- On 12 April 1915 he proceeded to join the Mediterranean Expeditionary Force to Gallipoli from Egypt
- On 27 April he received a gun shot wound to the shoulder and was transferred to 17th General Hospital then, on 12 June he was Taken on Strength and rejoined his Battalion on 13 June.
- On 31 July he was again wounded, then hospitalised and later returned to duty at Gallipoli on 25 December 1915
- 28 May 1916 he was transferred to 4th Machine Gun Company
- He was appointed Corporal on 4 June 1917
- He proceeded to France on 21 May 1918 and re-joined his Unit in France on 25 May 1918
- Corporal Percy DAVIS was Killed in Action on 4 July 1918 at Hamel Wood, France aged 25 years
- His war service was in Egypt, Gallipoli and on the Western Front
