

Clarence Edward FITZHERBERT

Pre-enlistment:

- Clarence Edward was born in 1889, in Charleville, Qld
- He was the foster son of Ellen Black of 27 Berley Street, Spring Hill, QLD who raised him from the age of 2 years
- His home town was Spring Hill, Qld
- His occupation at the time of enlistment was that of a clerk
- Some sources make reference to him as Charles Edward



Military Record

- Service Number: 1496
- Clarence FITZHERBERT enlisted on 26 January 1915 in Brisbane, attached to the 15th Infantry Battalion
- On 13 February 1915 embarked as a Private attached to the 15th Infantry Battalion 3rd Reinforcements, on the HMAT Seang Choon from Brisbane
- Later he embarked at Alexandria to join the Mediterranean Expeditionary Force at Gallipoli on 12 April 1915.
- His War Service took place in Egypt and Gallipoli with the 15th Infantry Battalion
- Private Clarence FITZHERBERT was killed in action on 4 May 1915 on the Gallipoli Peninsula.
