#### Pre-enlistment:

- Michael FLYNN was born at Junction Station, Weir River, Queensland
- He was the son of Michael FLYNN and Mary Ann RIDGWAY, his wife
- The school he attended was at Turallin, Queensland
- His occupation at the time of enlistment was that of a farm labourer in Millmerran, Toowoomba

## **Military Records**

- Service Number: 1831
- Michael FLYNN enlisted on 6 March 1916 in Toowoomba and was attached to the 42nd Battalion, 2nd Reinforcemen aged 22 years 9 months.
- On 16 August 1916 he embarked as a Private with his Unit on the HMAT Boorara, from Brisbane
- Disembarked at Plymouth England on 13 October 1916
- He joined 3 Div Training Brigade in England 21st November 1916
- He proceeded overseas to France on 20th December 1916 on the Princess Victoria
- He was Taken on Strenght by the 42nd Battalion
- Private Michael FLYNN was Killed In Action, on 11 February 1917 in France.
- His war service was on the Western Front.

• Michael Flynn was a member of the Millmerran Rifle Club and considered a fine shot.


