

Harry John GRAHAM



Pre-enlistment:

- Harry GRAHAM was born on 30 June 1885 in Brisbane, son of Thomas Andrew Graham and Rose Marie Graham of Barcaldine, QLD
- His schooling was at Gatton Agricultural College, Queensland
- His home town was Barcaldine, Qld
- He had been a member of the local Cadets.
- His occupation at the time of enlistment was that of a sheep farmer

Military Records

- Service Number: 154
- Harry John GRAHAM enlisted in the AIF on 4 September 1914 in Rockhampton, Qld
- On 24 September 1914 he embarked as a Private, with his Unit, the 9th Infantry Battalion, A Company on the HMAT Omrah, from Brisbane
- On 2 March 1915 he embarked Alexandria to join the Mediterranean Expeditionary Force, Gallipoli
- Private Harry GRAHAM was killed in action on 25 April 1915 in the first day of the Gallipoli landings. He was aged 29 years
- His War service was in both Egypt, Gallipoli
