Pre-enlistment:

- Walter JAMIESON was born in Scotland, to parents Alexander and Mary Jamieson of 192 Man Street, Camelon, Falkirk, Stirlingshire, Scotland
- · He came to Australia aged 28 years
- · He lived in Mareeba around the time of his enlistment

Military Service

- Service Number: 21235
- Walter JAMIESON enlisted on 25 November 1915 in Cairns attached to the 36th Battery, 9th F.A. Brigade as a Gunner, aged 29 years 11 months
- On 11 May 1916 he embarked with 9th Field Artillery Brigade, on HMAT Argyllshire, from Sydney
- He was appointed Bombardier in England on 10 July 1916
- He was transferred to 23rd F.A.B. on 10 September 1916
- He spent some time in hospital from 10 to 13 November 1916
- He proceeded overseas on 31 December 1916 from Southampton and marched in to the 23rd F.A.B. in the Field on 6 January 1917
- He was Taken on Strength in the Field on 9 March 1917
- He was admitted to hospital in June of 1917 then spent time in Havre, at the Australian General Base in France
- He marched into his Unit with 10th Field Artillery Brigade on 24 August 1917 and Taken on Strength in the Field on 27 August 1917
- He was wounded in action in Belgium on 21 October 1917 with multiple injuries including his chest and right shoulder
- His last Unit was the 10th Field Artillery Brigade, 23rd
 Howitzer Battery
- Bombardier Walter JAMIESON died of wounds in the 2nd Canadian Casualty Clearing Station, Belgium on 22 October 1917, Third Ypes, Flanders, Belgium
- · His was service was on the Western Front.
