- Herbert Hengest Rivett KITT enlisted on 13 October 1916 in Brisbane as a Private with 52nd Infantry Battalion, 8th Reinforcement, aged 34 years 11 months
- On 23 Dec 1916, he embarked with the 52nd Infantry Battalion, on HMAT Demosthenes, from Sydney aged 35 years
- He disembarked in Plymouth on 3 March 1917
- He marched into 13th Training Battalion in Codford, England on 4 March 1917
- He proceeded overseas from Southampton on 14 June 1917
- He marched into 4th A.D.B.D on 15 June 1917 where he was Taken on Strength by his Unit on 4 July 1917 at Havre (Australian General Base Depot in France)
- · His War service was on the Western Front
- Private Herbert Hengest Rivett KITT was killed in action on 25 September 1917 in France
