Pre-enlistment:

- Thomas Logan was born on 30 March 1877 at Forest Hill Qld
- He attended Brisbane Grammar School
- He was married to Beatrice May Logan and they had 6 children
- At the time of enlistment he was a farmer at Forrest Hill, Lockyer Valley, Qld

• Previous Military Service: Boer War Service

- 1 Oct 1899: Involvement Private, SN 187, 1st Queensland Mounted Infantry
- 1 Nov 1899: Embarked Australian and Colonial Military Forces (Boer War / Boxer Rebellion), Private, SN 187, 1st Queensland Mounted Infantry, SS Cornwall, Brisbane - disembarking Cape Town 13 December 1899
- 31 Mar 1900: Wounded Australian and Colonial Military Forces (Boer War / Boxer Rebellion), Private, SN 187, 1st Queensland Mounted Infantry, Battle of Sanna's Post , Slight
- 13 Dec 1900: Embarked Australian and Colonial Military Forces (Boer War / Boxer Rebellion), Corporal, SN 187, 1st Queensland Mounted Infantry, SS Orient, Cape Town for return to Australia - disembarking Brisbane 17 January 1901
- 23 Jan 1901: Discharged Australian and Colonial Military Forces (Boer War / Boxer Rebellion), Corporal, SN 187, 1st Queensland Mounted Infantry

Military Records

- Service Number: 187, Major
- Thomas LOGAN enlisted on 20 August 1914 as a Major, with 2nd Light Horse Regiment, A Squadron aged 37 years
- On 4 September 1914 he embarked on HMAT A15 Star of England, Brisbane for Egypt then on to ANZAC / Gallipoli
- He was involved with the 2nd Light Horse Regiment in the August Offensive at Lone Pine, Suvla Bay, Sari Bair, The Nek and Hill 60 on the Gallipoli Peninsula
- Major Thomas James LOGAN was Killed in Action on 7 August 1915 at Gallipoli, aged 38 years
- His war service was in the Gallipoli Campaign
