

Ashley Codrington LORD

Pre-enlistment:

- Ashley Codrington LORD was born on 6th July, 1893 in Dulwich Hill, Sydney
- His parents were William Codrington Phipps LORD & Jane Ellen TATE who married in Sydney in 1892
- He attended Ipswich Grammar School, Queensland and was a member of the Senior Cadets
- His occupation on enlistment was that of a Bank Clerk with Bank of Australasia, Ipswich, Qld



Military Records

- Service Number: 882
- Ashley LORD enlisted at Mackay on 17 December 1914 aged 21 years 5 months
- He embarked on the 8 Apr 1915 as a Private, with the 2nd Light Horse Regiment, on board HMAT Star of England, from Brisbane for duty at 'ANZAC' / Gallipoli
- He joined M.E.F. at Gallipoli on 28 August 1915
- On 24 September 1915 was admitted to hospital for 2 days with diarrhoea before returning to duty
- He was transferred to 25th Infantry Battalion on 18 October 1915
- He received serious GSW (head) in action at Gallipoli on 13 December 1915 and transferred to the Hospital Ship 'Dunluce Castle'.
- Private Ashley LORD Died of Wounds on 16 December 1915 at sea, aged 22 years. He was buried at sea between ANZAC and Mudros
- His War service was in Egypt and Gallipoli
