

Norman Henry MAZLIN



Pre-enlistment:

- Norman Mazlin was born on 24 April 1892 in Herberton, Queensland
- His parents were William and Isabella MAZLIN, Dublin Street, Clayfield, Brisbane. Native of Herberton. His mother was later named as his Next of Kin.
- Brother to Leslie Wright Mazlin
- His hometown was Herberton, Atherton Tablelands
- He attended Herberton State School
- His occupation prior to enlisting was that of a labourer though he had done some teacher training and he was single.

Military Records

- Served on the Australian expeditionary Force to Rabaul (German New Guinea)
 - Mobilised for War Service with 2nd A.N. & M.E.F.
 - Embarked at Cairns on 8 August 1914 for Thursday Island (War Station) Garrison Duty
 - Enlisted 14 August 1914 for service outside Australia
 - Re-embarked at Thursday Island on 16 August 1914, on Troopship 'Kanowna' to take part in the capture of German New Guinea
 - 'Taken on Strength' of the A.N. & M.E.F on 6 August 1914
 - Returned to Townsville on 18 September 1914, on account of the trouble caused by the firemen on troopship
 - Discharged 18 September 1914.

Military Records

- Service Number: 168
- Norman Mazlin enlisted on 17 September 1914 as a Private in Townsville, Queensland with the 15th Battalion, A Company, the original A Company
- 22 Dec 1914 he embarked on HMAT Ceramic, from Melbourne aged 22
- He was admitted to 16th Casualty Clearing Station, Mudros, 21 July 1915 (enteritis); then transferred to Convalescent Camp.
- He was again admitted to hospital, 31 July 1915
- His brother: 167 Pte Leslie Wright MAZLIN, 15th Bn, who enlisted at the same time as ,was killed in action, Gallipoli, 30 April 1915, age 21. They had consecutive regimental numbers
- His War service was in Egypt and Gallipoli
- Private Norman Henry MAZLIN was Killed in Action at Gallipoli on 8 August 1915, aged 23 years
