Pre-enlistment:

- John O'Sullivan was born in 1875 at Kilmeen, Rossmore, Cork, Ireland.
- He was the son of Denis and Nora O'Sullivan of County Cork, Ireland later of 'Ashmount' Muckadilla, Qld
- His hometown was Herberton, Atherton Tablelands, Qld
- His occupation was that of a miner
- He was single
- His next of kin was listed as his father, Dennis O'Sullivan, Ashmount, Muchadulla,

Military Records

- Service Number: 622
- John O'Sullivan enlisted on 2 November 1914, at Herberton, Qld with 5th Light Horse Regiment 2nd Reinforcement, as a Private
- On 19 December 1914 he embarked with his Unit on HMAT Vestalia, from Sydney aged 39 years
- Trooper John O'Sullivan was killed in action at ANZAC Cove, Gallipoli on 28 June 1915, aged 44 years
- His war service was in the Gallipoli Campaign

- Place of burial: Shell Green Cemetery (Plot II, Row K, Grave No. 18), Gallipoli, Turkey
- Australian War Memorial Roll of Honour Panel number 4
