Pre-enlistment:

- Paul Reynolds was born in Brisbane
- His occupation was that of a carpenter
- He lived at Cecil Street, Indooroopilly, Brisbane
- He named his mother, Mrs E Reynolds also of Cecil Street, as his next of kin.

Military Records

- Service Number: 6060
- Paul Reynolds enlisted on 30 July 1915 in Brisbane as a Gunner in 103rd Battery, in 21st Howitzer Brigade
- On 9 November 1915 he embarked with his Unit on HMAT Wandilla, Melbourne, aged 21 years
- His last Rank was that of a Driver
- His last Unit was the 3rd Field Artillery Brigade
- His War Service was in the Campaign on the Western Front
- Driver Paul Reynolds died of disease on 12 May 1916, in France
