Pre-enlistment:

- William Richardson was born in London, England
- He lived in Brisbane, Queensland
- His occupation was that of an engineer
- He was single
- His next of kin was listed as his brother, T H Richardson, George Street, Surry Hills, Sydney

Military Records

- Service Number: 21099
- William Richardson enlisted on 1 December 1915 as a Gunner with the 9th Field Artillery Brigade, Brigade Ammunition Column
- He embarked with his Unit from Sydney, NSW, on board HMAT A8 Argyllshire on 11 May 1916 aged 44 years
- His last Unit was the 9th Field Artillery Brigade
- He served and fought on the Western Front
- Private William Richardson died in King George Hospital of Bronchial Pneumonia on 31 March 1916 while on leave
