Pre-enlistment:

- Daniel Schaumburg was born in Millmerran, Qld
- His next of kin was listed as his mother, Jane SCHAUMBURG also of Millmerran
- His home town was Millmerran, which is where his occupation was that of a carter
- He was a single man

Military Records

- Service Number 5912
- Daniel Schaumburg enlistment on the 31 July 1916, in Toowoomba as a Private with the 26th Battalion, 16th Reinforcement
- On 21 October 1916 he embarked with his Unit on HMAT Boonah, from Brisbane, aged 19 years
- His last Unit was the 26th Infantry Battalion
- His war service was on the Western Front
- Private Daniel Schaumburg was killed in action on 3 October 1918, in France
