

Reginald George Hornby SCHOFIELD

Pre-enlistment:

- Reginald was born in 1883 in London, England to parents George Schofield and Emily Schofield of Dulwich, England formerly of 65 Belvedere Road. Upper Norwood, London, England.
- His home town was Millmerran, Toowoomba, Queensland
- His occupation at the time of enlistment was that of a settler



Military Records

- Service Number: 786
- Reginald SCHOFIELD enlisted on 23 September 1914 at Millmerran, QLD as a Private, aged 31 years
- He was attached to the 15th Infantry Battalion
- On 22 Dec 1914 he was attached to the 17th Infantry Battalion
- On 22 Dec 1914 he embarked with his Unit in the 17th Infantry Battalion on HMAT Ceramic from Melbourne
- His brother of Norman Charles Schofield was killed in action on 27 April 1915 while serving with the 15th Battalion (the same Unit as Reginald) and he was buried in the Lone Pine Cemetery Row O, Grave 26
- Private Reginald George Hornsby SCHOFIELD was killed in action on 24 May 1915 at Gallipoli with his original Unit in the 15th Infantry Battalion, 4th Infantry Brigade
- His War Service was in both Egypt, Gallipoli

- Reginald Schofield was a member of the Millmerran District Rifle Club and on his Attestation Papers indicated he also belonged to the Rifle Club Reserves
