- Frederick Swain was born in 1895 in Summerhill, Sydney, NSW. He had a mother, Eliza SWAIN, and foster brother, Augustus WHITBURN, of Wingham, NSW
- · He attended Church of England School, NSW
- He gave his address as Strathcedar, Wingham, though his home town was Millaa Millaa on the Tablelands near Cairns
- His occupation was that of a farm labourer and he was single
- Next of kin Mother, Mrs Whitburn, Strathcedar, Wingham, NSW

# **Previous Military Service:**

- Mobilised for War Service with 2nd A.N.& M.E.F.
- Embarked at Cairns on 8 August 1914 for Thursday Island (War Station) Garrison Duty
- Enlisted 14 August 1914 for service outside Australia
- Re-embarked at Thursday Island on 16 August 1914, on Troopship 'Kanowna' to take part in the capture of German New Guinea
- 'Taken on Strength' of the A.N. & M.E.F on 6 August 1914
- Returned to Townsville on 18 September 1914, on account of the trouble caused by the firemen on troopship
- Discharged 18 September 1914.

### Military Records

Service Number: 201

- Frederick Swain enlisted on the 28 September 1914, as a Sergeant with the 15th Battalion, A Company, at Enoggera, Queensland.
- On 22 December 1914 he embarke, with his Unit on board HMAT Ceramic, from Melbourne, aged 19 years
- His last Unit was the 15th Infantry Battalion
- His war service was in Egypt and Gallipoli
- · Private Frederick Cecil SWAIN was killed in action at Quinn's Post Gallipoli on 19 May 1915, aged 20 years
