Pre-enlistment:

- Bertram was born in Melbourne, Vic to parents, Andrew Bertram and Janet AITKEN, 'Marciaville', Charlotte Street, Leichhardt, NSW. Native of Victoria
- Prior to enlistment his occupation was that of a stockman as a single man
- The address listed was Goondiwindi, Qld
- Prior to enlisting he worked from 9 January 1915 to 18 August 1915 with the AIF Queensland as Bertram Andrew Aitkin
- He identified his next of kin as his father, Mr Andrew Bertram Aitkin, 21 Broadway, Glebe, Sydney

Military Records

- Regimental number 2124
- Bertram Anderson enlisted in Warwick Qld. He was also known as Bertram Andrew AITKIN
- He enlisted on 9 March 1916 (from his Attestation Papers) but date of enlistment from the Nominal Roll was 2 March 1916
- He enlisted as a Private with 49th Battalion, 4th Reinforcement
- He embarked with his Unit from Brisbane, on board HMAT A42 Boorara on 16 August 1916 aged 29 years
- Private Bertram (Bert) Anderson was killed in action on 6 April 1917 in France
- His war service was on the Western Front
