- He attended Coorparoo State School
- He was a member of school cadets for 18 months
- He lived at the family home in Ellis St, Coorparoo
- His occupation was that of a clerk
- · His next of kin was listed as his mother, Mrs Mary Oram Boyd

Military Records

- Service Number: 3039
- James Boyd enlisted on 24 October 1916 as a Private in Brisbane with the 41st Battalion, 7th Reinforcement
- He embarked with his Unit from Sydney, on board HMAT A18 Wiltshire on 7 February 1917 aged 28 years
- He disembarked at Devonport, England on 11 April 1917 and reported for duty at Durrington Camp, England on 23 April 1917 then on to Brigade Signal School in Fovant in Wiltshire.
- He proceeded overseas from Southampton to Harve, France on 20 March 1918
- He was taken on strength in the field by the 43rd Battalion on 24 March 1918, then spent some time at Brigade Headquarters
- He re-joined the 43rd Infantry Battalion in the field on 19 June 1917 at the Front in France
- · His War Service was on the Western Front
- Private James Boyd was killed in action on 22 August 1918 at Bray, Somme Sector, France when fighting with the 43rd Battalion. He was aged 30 years.
