# Thomas Robert IRWIN

#### Pre-enlistment:

- Thomas was born in 1895 in Bundaberg Qld to parents, Robert and Gertrude IRWIN, of Cordalba, Qld
- He was a single man living at Cordalba via Childers and working as a farm labourer at the time of enlistment.
- His next of kin was listed as his mother, Mrs Gertrude Ellen Irwin, Cordalba via Childers, Qld



### **Military Records**

- · Service Number: 79
- Thomas Irwin enlisted on 11 February 1916 as a Private with Machine Gun Company 11 in Brisbane, Qld.
- He embarked with his Unit from Sydney, NSW, on board HMAT A30 Borda on 5 June 1916, aged 21
- · He disembarked Alexandria on 12 July 1916
- He was promoted Temporary Sergeant on 20 November 1916
- He proceeded overseas from Southampton to France on 23 November 1916.
- He was admitted to hospital with mumps on 2 December 1916 and re-joined his Unit in the field on 29 December 1916
- On 2 March 1917 he reverted to Corporal
- He was transferred to Machine Gun Company,
  Grantham, England from France on 1 January 1917 and promoted Sergeant on 13 February 1917

- On 7 September 1917 he proceeded overseas from Southampton to France
- He was admitted to hospital on 1 November 1917 for a few days
- He was promoted 2nd Lieutenant on 1 December 1917, then promoted Lieutenant on 1 March 1918
- He was wounded in action on 6 May 1918 then wounded again on 8 August 1918
- Lieutenant Thomas Robert Irwin died of wounds 8 August 1918 that he sustained in action in France when on duty with 3rd Machine Gun Battalion. He was 23 years old.
- His war service was in Egypt and on the Western Front.
