

John Thomas McMUNN



Pre-enlistment:

- John was born in Riverview, Brisbane
- He was the son of Stephen and Honor McMUNN.
- He lived in Bridge Street, Woolloowin, Brisbane
- He gained his education at St James' College, Christian Brothers' College Gregory Terrace, Brisbane
- He was single
- His occupation at time of enlistment was that of an Insurance Clerk with the Atlas Insurance Co Ltd Brisbane from 1906.

Military Records

- Service Number: 4187
- John McMunn enlisted on 27 August 1915, at Brisbane with the 25th Battalion, 10th Reinforcement
- He embarked with his Unit on 28 March 1916 on board HMAT Commonwealth, from Brisbane aged 24 years to Egypt where he spent time training
- He embarked 30 May 1916 at Alexandria and disembarked at Marseilles, France 5 June 1916
- On 2 August 1916 he was taken on strength by 25th battalion
- He fought at Pozieres in August 1916
- Private John Thomas McMunn was killed in action (previously reported missing) on 14 November 1916 at Fleurs, France during an unsuccessful raid on a German trench, aged 25 years
- His war service was in Egypt and on the Western Front

- Cemetery: No known grave - "Known Unto God"
- Memorial: Australian War Memorial Roll of Honour Panel Number 105
- Villers-Bretonneux Memorial, Villers-Bretonneux, Picardie, France
