

Stanely Archer O'TOOLE



Pre-enlistment:

- Stanley was born in Sydney
- He lived in Rockhampton
- His occupation at time of enlistment was that of a mechanic
- As his next of kin he listed his mother Mrs Gertrude O'Toole, 100 Kent Street, Rockhampton

Military Records

- Service Number: 3884
- Stanley O'Toole enlisted in Rockhampton on 26 August 1915 as a Private with the 5th Battalion, 9th Reinforcement aged 26 years
- He embarked with his Unit from Brisbane, Queensland, on board HMAT Wandilla on 31 January 1916
- On 2 April 1916 he was taken on strength by the 49th Battalion in Serapeum, Suez Canal
- He proceeded overseas from Alexandria on 5 June 1916, and arrived in Marseilles on 12 June and proceeded to join his Unit on the front line.
- His War Service was in Egypt and on the Western Front
- Private Stanley O'Toole was killed in action on 14 August 1916, France
