- His occupation at time of enlistment was that of a labourer
- His address was Barolin, Bundaberg and he was a single man
- His next of kin was listed as his mother, Mrs B Shearin, Barolin, Bundaberg

- Edward Shearin enlisted on 18 October 1915 in Brisbane, Qld, as a Private with 9th Battalion, 15th Reinforcement
- He embarked with his Unit from Brisbane, Qld, on board HMAT A73 Commonwealth on 28 March 1916, aged 21
- He was transferred from 2nd Australian Stationary Hospital, Tel el Kebir, to 4th Australian Hospital, Abbassia, 24 May 1916 with mumps; then transferred to England and admitted to 3rd Training Battalion Brigade Hospital, on 9 July 1916. He marched out to 3rd Training Battalion on 18 July 1916.

- He proceeded overseas to France on 31 July 1916, then taken on strength by 9th Battalion on 13 August 1916.
- He was admitted to 5th Australian Field Ambulance on 15 November 1916 with sore feet; discharged to duty on 21 November 1916 and re-joined the Battalion on 22 November 1916.
- He was admitted to 36th Casualty Clearing Station, on 1 December 1916 (sore feet); transferred by Ambulance Train No 36, on 1 December 1916, and admitted to 8th General Hospital, Rouen on 3 December 1916; then to 2nd Convalescent Depot on 8 December 1916; to 1st Australian Division Base Depot, Etaples on 12 December 1916; and re-joined the Battalion on 7 January 1917.
- He took leave to United Kingdom on 13 September 1917 and re-joined the Unit in Belgium on 25 September 1917
- Private Edward Thomas Shearin was killed in action in Belgium on 7 October 1917
- His war service was in Egypt and on the Western Front
