Modified: -

.303 Service rifles fitted with range sights.

Central, Parker Hale set, Dioptres Allowed.

Slings allowed.

No Eagle Eyes.

Post front sight only, no rings.

Scoped: -

303 Service rifles fitted with scopes.

Scopes to be set to a maximum of 15 power

Front Rest or Bipod may be used, No Rear Bag.

Modified timbers allowed

RSL: -

Any 303 Service rifle.

Modified timbers allowed

Note: - All Classes Rifles to be fired from the prone position.
Benches are allowed for those eligible.
